- Socks

- Belt
- Hat
- 1 extra pair of shoes
- flip flops – for wearing in the room like slippers

STUFF

- Clothespin (for closing drapes and a zillion other uses)
- Stopper for sink
- Small roll of duct tape (Office Max has tiny rolls)
